ORDINANCE NO. 12495

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, PART II, CHAPTER 26, SECTIONS 26-22, 26-23, 26-24 26-25, AND 26-134, AND BY ADDING NEW SECTIONS 26-26, 26-27, 26-28, 26-29, 26-30, 26-31, 26-32, 26-33, AND 26-34, ESTABLISHING THE EVENT FEES FOR USAGE OF VARIOUS CHATTANOOGA PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 26, Section 26-22, be and the same is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

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SECTION 3. That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 26, Section 26-24, be and the same is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

The following fee schedule shall apply to usage of the waterfront area for events of more than five hundred (500) individuals that fall within the following categories enumerated herein and are held in the parks and facilities specified in this section. For Category four (4) and five (5) events, a license agreement shall be entered into with the City of Chattanooga establishing the fee amount, which shall not be less than the amount set forth for category three (3) events. A deposit shall be required for use of the waterfront area in an amount equal to one day of rental for each venue utilized by the event.

<b>Description of Categories</b>	
Category 1	No sales, admission fees, concessions, entry fees, pledges or donations.
	Funds to produce the event may be obtained from grants, donations, or sales that occur off site prior to event.
	OR
	Runs/Walks where no entry fee is charged to participate.
	Pledges in support of a charity may be collected off site.
Category 2	Closed to the public, with or without a fee.
Category 3	Commercial: The purpose of the event is to distribute information and/or introduce a product that may result in present or future donations or sales.
	OR
	Sales: Events where concessions, and/or sales are part of the event. Runs, walks, contests where entry fees are charged in order to participate and the end event is combined with a festival-type event (beer gardens, bands, or similar activity).
	OR
	Festival-type events where there are sales. Sales are limited to eight (8) vendors. These vendors are for providing food services to the public and event personnel during the event. Vendors may also provide specific event-related goods & services that closely follow the theme or subject Matter of the event. No admission may be charged to the festival. No donations may be collected. This Category is limited to one-day (including set up and take down) events with an attendance of 1,000 People or less. In addition to the usage fee, a separate Category per-vendor charge is assessed.
Category 4	Runs, walks, contests where entry fees are charged in order to participate and race memorabilia may be sold on site. Race memorabilia is limited

	to T-shirts, sweatshirts or other race-related items which have a per item cost of \$25 or less.
Category 5	Limited access/entrance fees: Events in this Category will be charged three (3) times Category 3. These are events that totally fence the area and charge an admission fee.

SECTION 15. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.


