ORDINANCE NO. 13928

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHATTANOOGA CITY CODE, PART II, CHAPTER 26, SECTIONS 26-23, 26-24, 26-25, 26-26, 26-27, 26-28, 26-29, 26-30, 26-31, 26-32, 26-33, 26-34, 26-58, AND 26-91, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR EVENTS, RENTALS, AND USAGE OF CHATTANOOGA PARKS, COMMUNITY CENTERS, AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. That Chattanooga City Code, Part II, Chapter 26, Sections 26-23, 26-24, 26-25, 26-26, 26-27, 26-28, 26-29, 26-30, 26-31, 26-32, 26-33, 26-34, 26-58, and 26-91, be and the same are hereby amended by deleting said sections in their entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the following:

Sec. 26-23. Rental Rates for Municipal Parks.

City sponsored events require the approval of the Mayor or Department of Parks & Outdoors Administrator or his designee. The following rental rates and fee schedule shall apply to events in these designated municipal parks:

Signature Park Event Reservations:

- Must secure a License Agreement through Parks & Outdoors Special Events Division.
- Refundable damage deposit will be required for all events.
- Rental fees and rates are detailed below.
- Event duration is a maximum of three (3) consecutive days without express written approval by the Department of Parks & Outdoors Administrator or his designee.

Category 1: Events with 15 - 500 attendees.

Category 2: Events with 501 or more attendees and/or alcohol will be served or sold and/or planned activities are expected to damage park grounds.

The Administrator of the Department of Parks & Outdoors is responsible for oversight of municipal golf courses.

There is hereby established the following fee schedule for municipal golf courses:

- City residents are entitled to a two dollar (\$2.00) discount on eighteen (18) hole green fees.
- City employees are entitled to the same discount as city residents when they present their employee ID badge.
- Discount does not apply to nine (9) hole green fees or junior fee.
- All golfers pay the same rate on weekends and holidays.
- The Golf Manager may adjust green fees a maximum of twenty five percent (25%) due to course and/or market conditions and may offer special discounts and play incentives to increase use of municipal golf courses and may offer special incentives to large groups.
- City residents and city employees are entitled to a fifteen percent (15%) discount from the rates for annual passes.
- Half price pass entitles the pass holder to half price green fees and half price cart rentals at either golf course on non-holiday weekdays only.
