A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY AND ACCEPT AN EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT - LOCAL SOLICITATION FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ADMINISTRATION IN WASHINGTON, D.C., IN A TOTAL AMOUNT OF TWO TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND HUNDRED HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$228,752.00), OF WHICH SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$74,825.00) WILL GO TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT AND ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$153,927.00) OF WHICH WILL GO TO THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT, WITH NO MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED, FOR PURPOSES SPECIFIED HEREIN, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY AND HAMILTON COUNTY FOR THE SHARING OF SAID FUNDS AS SPECIFIED ABOVE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That the Chief of Police be and is hereby authorized to apply for an Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant — Local Solicitation from the Bureau of Justice Administration in Washington, D.C., in a total amount of \$228,752.00, of which \$74,825.00 will go to the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department and \$153,927.00 of which will go to the Chattanooga Police Department, with no local matching funds required, and authorizing the Mayor to execute an agreement between City and Hamilton County for the sharing of said funds as specified above. These Chattanooga funds will be used for the following:

- (1) Community Outreach programs including the Citizens Police Academy;
- (2) Crime Prevention Programs; and
- (3) Technology needs of the Police Department.
