DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR AND, IF AWARDED.

ACCEPT A FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT-SUPPLEMENTAL (AFG-S) OPPORTUNITY, WHICH IS A

SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY FOR FIRE DEPARTMENTS TO OUICKLY RECOVER COSTS DIRECTLY ASSOCIATED

WITH EXPENSES RELATED TO COVID-19, WITH THE

CITY'S TEN (10%) PERCENT MATCH IN THE AMOUNT OF

EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$8,000.00), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$80,000.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That the Chattanooga Fire Department is hereby authorized to apply for and, if

awarded, accept a FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Grant-Supplemental (AFG-S) opportunity,

which is a special opportunity for fire departments to quickly recover costs directly associated

with expenses related to COVID-19, with the City's ten (10%) percent match in the amount of

\$8,000.00, for a total amount of \$80,000.00.

The department is applying for funds to recover costs already incurred in response to the

pandemic, such as purchases for personal protective equipment (PPE), including N-95 masks,

SCBA mask cartridges, gowns, disinfectant, hand sanitizers, etc.

In addition, the Chattanooga Fire Department will seek funding for expenses that have

not yet occurred but are anticipated for disinfectant foggers, more N-95 masks, and more

disinfectant.
