

RESOLUTION NO. 30767

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION (“NRC”) FOR USE OF THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT FACILITIES TO PROVIDE TRAINING COURSES FOR THE NRC PERSONNEL AND CONTRACTORS, FOR A ONE (1) YEAR PERIOD AND FOUR (4) TWELVE (12) MONTH OPTIONAL PERIODS, FOR THE LIFE OF THE FIVE (5) YEAR CONTRACT, FOR AN AMOUNT PAYABLE FOR YEAR ONE (1) OF FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$55,000.00) AND THE NEXT FOUR (4) YEARS OF FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) TO THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, FOR CONTRACT PERIOD BEGINNING APRIL 1, 2021, THROUGH MARCH 31, 2026, FOR A TOTAL ESTIMATED AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$255,000.00), SUBJECT TO ANY PARTICIPANTS SIGNING LIABILITY WAIVER AND ASSUMPTION OF RISKS AGREEMENT PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION IN SUCH TRAINING ON CITY PROPERTY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Chief of Police to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) for use of the Chattanooga Police Department facilities to provide training courses for the NRC personnel and contractors, for a one (1) year period and four (4) twelve (12) month optional periods, for the life of the five (5) year contract, for an amount payable for year one (1) of \$55,000.00 and the next four (4) years of \$50,000.00 to the City of Chattanooga, for contract period beginning April 1, 2021, through March 31, 2026, for a total estimated amount not to exceed \$255,000.00, subject to any participants signing Liability Waiver and Assumption of Risk Agreement prior to participation in such training on city property.
