A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF

MELISSA MORTIMER, AS A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT LAND DEVELOPMENT

OFFICE, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN,

SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That MELISSA MORTIMER, be and is hereby appointed as a special police officer

for the Department of Economic and Community Development Land Development Office, subject

to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officer

of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of her duties, except her duty shall not be

allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer

are expressly limited to the performance of duties in her position as Historic Preservation Planner.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and

shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's

employment with the Department of Economic and Community Development Land Development

Office. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga

shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
