A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A FISCAL YEAR 2021 LAW ENFORCEMENT MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLNESS ACT GRANT THROUGH THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS OFFICE) TO ASSIST AND DEVELOP A PEER SUPPORT TEAM USED FOR OFFICERS RESILIENCE TRAINING, FAMILY RESOURCES, SUICIDE PREVENTION, CRISIS INTERVENTION TRAINING, AND TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES, FOR A GRANT PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$124,360.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Chief of Police to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Fiscal Year 2021 Law Enforcement Mental Health and Wellness Act Grant through the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) to assist and develop a Peer Support Team used for officers resilience training, family resources, suicide prevention, crisis intervention training, and technology resources, for a grant period beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2023, for an amount not to exceed \$124,360.00.
