

RESOLUTION NO. 30879

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT, ALONG WITH THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A FISCAL YEAR 2021 EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FOR A GRANT PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2025, FOR PURCHASE OF TRAINING EQUIPMENT, TO AWARD A SHARED GRANT TO THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$106,488.00), AND TO THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, IN THE AMOUNT OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$45,637.00), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS (\$152,125.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Chattanooga Police Department, along with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Fiscal Year 2021 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) from the Department of Justice, for a grant period beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2025, for purchase of training equipment, to award a shared grant to the Chattanooga Police Department, in the amount of \$106,488.00, and to the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, in the amount of \$45,637.00, for a total amount not to exceed \$152,125.00.
