A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF TREVOR MOORER, ANIMAL PROTECTION OFFICER, AS

SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR

MCKAMEY ANIMAL CENTER, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS

PRESCRIBED HEREIN. SUBJECT TO **CERTAIN**

CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That TREVOR MOORER, be and is hereby appointed as special police officer for

the McKamey Animal Center, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police

officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except he shall not

be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police

officers are expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Animal Protection

Officer.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and

shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointments shall expire upon termination of said special police

officer's employment by the McKamey Animal Center. Notwithstanding any other provision

herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointments

at any time.
