A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT, ALONG WITH THE HAMILTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, TO APPLY FOR, AND IF AWARDED, ACCEPT A FISCAL YEAR 2022 EDWARD BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FOR A GRANT PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026, WITH A SHARED GRANT AWARD TO THE CHATTANOOGA POLICE DEPARTMENT, IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE DOLLARS (\$117,489.00) FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT, AND HAMILTON COUNTY TO BE AWARDED FIFTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$50,352.00), FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-ONE DOLLARS (\$167,841.00).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That it is authorizing the Chattanooga Police Department, along with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Office, to apply for, and if awarded, accept a Fiscal Year 2022 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant from the Department of Justice, for a grant period beginning October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2026, with a shared grant award to the Chattanooga Police Department, in the amount of \$117,489.00 for the purchase of equipment, and Hamilton County to be awarded \$50,352.00, for a total amount not to exceed \$167,841.00.
