A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY HEALTH (OCH) TO APPLY TO SERVE AS A HOST SITE FOR TWO (2) ADDITIONAL CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL (CDC) PUBLIC HEALTH ASSOCIATE PROGRAM (PHAP) PUBLIC HEALTH PROFESSIONAL, FIELD-ASSIGNED (FOR TWO (2) YEARS) POSITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That it is hereby authorizing the Office of Community Health (OCH) to apply to serve as a Host Site for two (2) additional Centers for Disease Control (CDC) Public Health Associate Program (PHAP) public health professional, field-assigned (for two (2) years) positions.

The current CDC PHAP assignee contributes to a high degree to the Office of Community Health (OCH). These two (2) additional CDC-paid, two (2) year positions, if approved, will contribute to and support additional OCH program activities in the Family Justice Center (FJC) and Community Safety and Gun Violence Prevention areas at a significant cost savings for the City of Chattanooga.
