A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF

MICHAEL PARKER AS A SPECIAL COMMISSIONED POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR MCKAMEY ANIMAL

SERVICES, TO PERFORM DUTIES EXPRESSLY LIMITED TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DUTIES IN THE

POSITION OF ANIMAL PROTECTION OFFICER.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,

TENNESSEE, That MICHAEL PARKER, be and is hereby appointed as special police officer

for McKamey Animal Services, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess, and exercise every power

granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police

officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except he shall

not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police

officer is expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Animal Protection

Officer.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer

and shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointment shall expire upon termination of said special police

officer's employment by McKamey Animal Services. Notwithstanding any other provision

herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such

appointment at any time.
