A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RELEASE OF K-9
KODA AS A SERVICE DOG.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA,
TENNESSEE, that it is hereby authorizing the release of K-9 Koda as a service dog.

- 1) Koda is six (6) years old with no stats as he never made it to a functioning dual purpose K-9 for the Chattanooga Police Department;
- 2) Koda was purchased in 2017 for \$6,000;
- 3) Koda has become a liability and a safety risk to his handler. Our K-9 trainers have indicated Koda has become untrainable and should be released from duty for retirement; and
- 4) Koda will be donated to Tom Caywood from Sequoyah K-9. He has agreed and is willing to accept all responsibilities for Koda's future care such as medical, food, and housing.
