Recognition - New Board Member and City Personnel Department Intern

The Board welcomed new member Steve Perry. Mr. Perry is currently the Chief Financial Officer and Vice President of Finance with Blood Assurance in Chattanooga.

Daisy Madison requested that Doug Kelley introduce Drew Dunn, a volunteer intern in Personnel who is currently working on his MBA at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga.

Administrative Budget FY2012 and General Pension Plan Website

Doug Kelley presented the administrative budget for fiscal year 2012 to the Board. The budget request included the normal 2.5% increase in actuary fees, a \$5,000.00 increase in consultant fees and a slight reduction in the fees for First Tennessee Bank. The long-term disability premium was added as a new item to the budget (included 5% increase in the premium). The remaining fees, with the exception of the General Pension Plan Website, remained consistent.

The General Pension Plan Website hosting fee budget item was discussed. An updated Website for the city is currently under development. Doug Kelley inquired if the General Pension Plan Website could be hosted by the city based on service issues with the current vendor. He mentioned to the Board about previous inquiries with Phillip Stevens, Web Master working in the Mayor's Office, and Cory Wentz, IT Business Project Analyst with Information Services with the city, which had resulted in a positive reaction from both gentlemen. The Board, on motion from Dan Johnson, unanimously approved this request. Mr. Johnson also approved working with Phillip Stevens on the General Pension Plan Website.

On motion by Dan Johnson, seconded by Terry Lamb, the Board unanimously approved the administrative budget for fiscal year 2012. A copy of the budget will be included with the minutes.

Meeting of Trustees City of Chattanooga General Pension Plan June 16, 2011

Administrative Issues - General Pension Plan

The Board unanimously approved recommending that the city's contribution rate into the General Pension Plan based on the salaries of all participants increase to 12.95% for fiscal year 2012 as specified in the most recent actuarial study prepared by EFI. The Board had previously deferred this action during their May 19, 2011 meeting.

On motion of Terry Lamb, seconded by Steve Perry, the Board unanimously approved the transfer of up to \$4,000,000.00 from fixed income to cover benefit payments and miscellaneous expenses for the third quarter of 2011. This will be a routine action for the Board to discuss and ratify on the last month of each quarter for the following quarter.

The Board discussed their meeting schedule. The Board arrived at the consensus to keep their meeting on the third Thursday of each month and to commence at 8:30 a.m. in the J.B. Collins Conference Room – City Council.

Daisy Madison mentioned to the Board about an invitation by Mr. Mike Andrews to his annual pension summit in Chicago, Illinois. Daisy Madison and Michael McMahan both encouraged Board members to attend educational conferences. Use of the education fund would be available.

The next Board meeting is scheduled for August18, 2011 at 8:30 a.m. in the J. B. Collins Conference Room.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
