

HOW TO DRIVE A ROUNDABOUT

1) APPROACH AND ENTRY (A)

2) EXITING THE ROUNDABOUT (C)

• Once you have entered the roundabout, proceed counter-clockwise to your exit point. You now have the right of way. · As you approach your exit, turn on your right turn signal. • Exit the roundabout.

3) TRUCKS (D)

• When approaching a roundabout <u>slow down</u> and be prepared to yield. Beware of pedestrians in the crosswalk.

• Look to the left and check for approaching traffic in the circulating roadway which has the right of way (B).

• Pull up to the Yield Line and wait for a gap in the circulating traffic or enter if there is an adequate gap in traffic.

• Roundabouts have very tight curves that are difficult for trucks to navigate. For this reason, a truck apron is provided.

• The truck may drive on the raised pavement of the truck apron to navigate the roundabout easier.

• The truck apron is 3" higher than the driving pavement to discourage
