## **COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**

February 16, 2016 6:00 PM

## **CALL TO ORDER**

Council Chairwoman Carol Berz called the meeting to order with Vice Chair Moses Freeman and Council members Chris Anderson, Russell Gilbert, Larry Grohn, Yusuf Hakeem, Chip Henderson, Jerry Mitchell and Ken Smith all present. Deputy City Attorney Phil Noblett and Council Clerk Nicole Gwyn, CMC, were also present.

## **Transportation**

Blythe Bailey, Transportation Administrator, introduced Bertran Kuyrkendall, Transportation Engineer, to give a presentation entitled, "Pedestrian Action Plan." Mr. Kuyrkendall gave an overview of the Pedestrian Action Plan and also discussed the following:

- Walkable City Map
- Population Density Map
- Potential Pedestrian Index
- ADA Transition Plan
- Public Input

Mr. Kuyrkendall responded to questions from Councilmen Hakeem on the location of the two public meetings already held. He responded to a question from Councilman Henderson about the plan of action for removing light poles to ensure the ADA Transition. He also responded to Vice Chair Freeman's questions about the "next steps" in the Avondale area, especially in repairing the broken sidewalks in that area.

Councilman Grohn commented concerning the safety of residents after the Gunbarrel Road expansion. Councilman Grohn voiced concerns of his constituents in the Mentone & Gunbarrel area who feel that the Transportation Department did not listen to their safety concerns. Councilman Gilbert later thanked Mr. Kuyrkendall for the work that has been done in his district and reiterated the need for sidewalks in his district.

David Carmody, Deputy Chief Operating Officer, briefed the Council on the following purchases:
