November 3, 2020 4:00 PM

#### **RESOLUTION #30548**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO ACCEPT AN ALLOCATION OF \$1,448,742.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT AWARDED UNDER THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT) AND TO USE THE FUNDING FOR THE ACQUISITION, RENOVATION, AND OPERATION OF A HOTEL/MOTEL TO SERVE AS A NON-CONGREGATE EMERGENCY SHELTER.

**Councilman Gilbert moved** to approve with the intent to amend the following: A resolution authorizing the Administrator for the Department of Public Works to accept the qualifications for Contract No. S-20-004-100 on-call modeling and floodplain analysis services from (1) Stantec; (2) CDM Smith; (3) Woods Environment and Infrastructure Solutions, Inc.; (4) AECOM; and (5) S&ME and to enter into five (5) one (1) year blanket contracts with these professional firms subject to three (3) one-year renewal options for professional services estimated at \$650,000.00 total annually for all five (5) professional firms for use by all departments. Councilman Ledford seconded.
