

RESOLUTION NO. 31400

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSHUA BURGESS, AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER (UNARMED) FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CODE ENFORCEMENT, TO DO SPECIAL DUTY AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN IN HIS POSITION AS CODE ENFORCEMENT, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That JOSHUA BURGESS, be and is hereby appointed as special police officer for the Department of Community Development Code Enforcement, subject to certain conditions and restrictions:

1. That said special police officer shall have, possess and exercise every power granted by the statutes of the State of Tennessee or the City of Chattanooga to regular police officers of the City of Chattanooga necessary in the performance of his duties, except he shall not be allowed to carry a firearm. Such powers and performance of duties by said special police officer is expressly limited to the performance of duties in his position as Code Enforcement.

2. That said special police officer shall not be considered a regular police officer and shall not be entitled to any benefits afforded regular police officers.

3. That such appointments shall expire upon termination of said special police officer's employment by the Department of Community Development Code Enforcement. Notwithstanding any other provision herein, the City Council of the City of Chattanooga shall have the right to cancel such appointment at any time.
